The 2018 annual Winter Woods Homeowner's Association Membership Drive is now underway and we have TWENTY-THREE families who have already joined for 2018. A big thank you to the families who took advantage of the opportunity to save an envelope and some postage by paying their 2017 and 2018 dues in one check.

While memberships are accepted throughout the year, <u>our membership year runs from January to December</u> so even if you paid your 2017 dues mid-year or even as late as last month, your dues for 2018 are now due. Your Board of Directors will soon be making plans for the 2018 garage sale along with other improvements to our neighborhood. But we need your dues to make things happen!

Please remember, our association is a <u>voluntary</u> one and we have one of the lowest dues rates in the metro Orlando area. But also keep in mind that for the tiny amount of \$15 per year, your association has been able to run the advertising for our community garage sale, and print our monthly newsletter along with keeping the grass cut and the islands maintained throughout our neighborhood. We also provided light snacks for the October National Night Out event for residents who came out to get to know their neighbors. Your membership dues also pays for the upkeep on the signs at all the entrances to our great neighborhood along with the signs we use to identify the Yard of the Month and, of course, those really cute signs that our "Three Wise Gals" put out to recognize our decorating contest winners. That's quite a great value for a small amount of money. 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HOLIDAY DECORATING CONTEST—Debra Stephey

The evening of December 17 was warm and bright with many holiday decorations as the Winter Woods Decorations committee started their search to find the best-decorated homes in Winter Woods. We are happy to report that the spirit of holiday decorating was very much alive in Winter Woods with over 100 homes participating!

We found numerous homes qualifying for award consideration. After much discussion, the final results from the collection of top displaying homes yielded this year's winners. The Fricke residence, 1943 Nottingham, was the choice of committee members for the "Over-the-Top Award" and the Hucko/Kimmel household at 2229 King Richards won the "Santa's Choice Award". The presentation at the Stojic residence, 2132 N. Hampton, won the "Committee's Award". The Brevard household at 2209 King Charles was the winner of the "President's Award". Winners were presented with a sign for display on their front lawns during the remainder of the holiday season. Your household had to be a 2017 paid member of the Winter Woods Homeowners Association in order to be considered for the four top awards. Cash prizes are no longer given to the award winners.

Many houses showed off the outstanding decorating efforts of the residents and received Honorable Mention, and the following is a list of those homes. The houses at 2233, 2238, 2250, and 2251 Coventry looked great. The three **Hampton Circles** had many nice decorations, and we were appreciative of the displays at 2051, 2119, 2143, and 2149 **North Hampton** as well as 1941, 2027, 2028, 2052, and 2146 **East Hampton** and at 2007, 2009, 2012, 2018, and 2117 West Hampton. On Japonica, the displays at 1928, 1935, 1942, 1949, 1956, 2012, 2019, and 2026 were all delightful. King Alpines was represented by house numbers 2214, 2225, 2226, and 2232. We found nicely decorated homes at 1946, 1952, 1957, 1960, 1961, 1964, and 1968 King Arthurs. King Charles had wonderful displays at 2215, 2221, 2227, and 2228. King Edwards addresses that were represented included 2247, 2254, 2263, 2266, and 2275. King Henrys had beautiful displays at 2246, 2251, 2257, 2264, 2272, and 2276. King James had houses at 2244, 2250, 2256, and 2265 shining brightly. The homes on King Johns at 2241 and 2252 were lit up as well. The houses at 2211, 2218, and 2223 King Richards made honorable mention. In addition, those displays at 1463, 1534, 1535, 1551, 1565, 1621, 1723, 1739, 1825, 1928, 2013, 2029, and 2131 Nottingham were all noticed. Poinciana looked good with decorations of note at 1810, 1843, 1853, 1887, 1955, 1958, 1965, 2080, 2092, 2097, 2118, 2122, 2245, 2246, 2251, and 2316. Sussex was well represented with homes at 2025, 2032, 2033, 2036, 2037, 2041, 2087, 2090, 2095, 2096, 2158, 2165, and 2177 all deserving mention, as well as 2255 **Tamerine**. Displays worthy of Honorable Mention on Winter Woods Blvd. were 2207, 2212, 2213, 2218, and 2224. Pictures of some of our best dressed homes are included in the emailed version of the newsletter but not in the printed version due to printing costs.

If your house was decorated but not noted, it could be because we were unable to locate a house number! We encourage all residents to make sure your address numbers are visible from the street at all times so that your home can be quickly identified by emergency responders! This is a safety issue far more important than holiday decorations.

We applaud the efforts of all homeowners who took the time to decorate for the holiday season and brighten up our neighborhood. In addition, sincere appreciation goes out to Cheryl Smith for storing the award signs year around, as well as to those residents who served on the Decorations committee. Thank you everyone!
