To help prepare for the writing of this article, I did an Internet search for "holiday crimes" and was surprised by the number of postings that reminded us that the Holiday Season is the most dangerous time of the year for criminal activity. They show that increased alcohol consumption, more people out shopping, and family gatherings all contribute to a spike in crime rates.

Of course, the usual suggestions for safety are offered such as not leaving packages exposed in cars, keeping a tight grip on purses and wallets and, of course, phones. They also recommend a heightened sense of situational awareness. When out after dark, know exactly where you parked your car and don't fumble with your keys once you are there.

Driving home now after work and it is dark, I am amazed at the number of vehicles that are moving without head or tail lights. We old timers remember when the dash board lights would not come on until the running lights were lit. Now, that indicator is gone and running lights can be on all the time. Don't take for granted that your vehicle lights are on. Also, have a buddy check those brake lights for you, too. Those bulbs don't last forever.

So, between having more hours of darkness and increased exposures to crime, the holidays can be a dangerous time. Don't let a moment's lapse of awareness spoil the holidays for you and your family. These are hurried times. Slow it down a bit and help everybody stay safe.
