PRESIDENT'S KORNER

You may have seen it in the news, but effective this Page 2 month, the Seminole County Fire Department will be upgraded to an ISO (Insurance Service Office) • Class I designation. To quote from their website

- Effective February 1, 2022, Seminole County Page 3 homeowners and local business owners may . qualify to receive a lower insurance renewal rate as a result of the ISO Class 1 rating earned by the Seminole County Fire Department (SCFD).
- This is the highest possible rating to be received Page 4 by the Public Protection Classification® from the Insurance Services Office. This rating places SCFD in the top .001% of the more than 40,000 fire departments in the nation rated by ISO.
- The Seminole County Fire Department's top ISO-1* rating means more safety and peace of mind for residents and businesses, as well as Page 6 possible lower insurance premiums."

They also say "In addition, there are only 10 counties across the country that are ISO-1 rated, with only 3 counties within the state of Florida with this • rating. "

They caution that not all insurance companies will • recognize the rating and reduce the rates. I am not sure about mine yet.

Elsewhere in this newsletter, there should be a photo and a note regarding our new Yard of the Month sign. The existing sign had been in use for many years and the support posts had rotted away. Board member Anna Swenson volunteered her husband, Eric Obara, to create a new sign for us.

To pay by credit card, click on the "Subscribe by Debit or Credit card" tab at the bottom of the PayPal screen, just to the left of the PayPal log-in. Please remember that PayPal automatically creates a recurring payment when you make your initial payment. Please be sure to log back in to your PayPal account and delete the recurring payment.

QR CODES AND THE DANGERS THEY POSE

Have you visited a nice restaurant recently? In an effort to reduce the costs involved with handing each customer a one-use only paper menu, many restaurants have gone to using QR codes so their diners can view the restaurant's entire menu on their phone. Restaurants are not the only establishments that have gone to using QR Codes—look in the aisles at your pharmacy or other retail outlets and you'll see signs with QR codes so you can get more information about a product or store.

BUT, there is a danger in just scanning the code at the table or on the sign at the store! Cybercriminals have figured out how popular QR Codes have become and they are placing stickers over top of the restaurant (or other merchant) QR Codes with one of their own that contains malware. The FBI is warning that cybercriminals have tampered with QR codes to steal consumers' login, financial information and money.

QR codes — technically, $\underline{\mathbf{Q}}$ uick $\underline{\mathbf{R}}$ esponse codes — are black-and-white squares and can be found just about everywhere. They've grown increasingly common during the pandemic, cybersecurity professionals say, as coronavirus fears have triggered a demand for touchless transactions. You can show a QR code on your smartphone screen to board an airplane or enter a sporting event, or use your phone's camera to scan a code to learn when the next bus is due. The codes also appear in direct-mail ads and at retail outlets.

The FBI has advised:

- Do not download an app from a QR code; instead use your phone's app store.
- Do not download a QR code scanner app. Most phones have a built-in scanner in their cameras.
- If you recently bought something and you receive an email saying the payment failed and are asked to complete the payment through a QR code, call the company to verify this. Locate the company's phone number from a trusted site, not the phone number given in the email.
- If you believe your funds have been stolen from an altered QR code, contact your local FBI field office.
