NEIGHBORHOOD WATCH—Larry Stephey

When Neighborhood Watch was first implemented in Winter Woods, the area was divided into 19 "blocks" with each block having a Block Captain. It was the Block Captain's responsibility to walk the block and meet the residents of each house, gather their names and phone numbers, and pass all that information on to the Neighborhood Watch Coordinator. The Block Captain would be the primary reporting point for suspicious or criminal activities.

The coordinator would compile the information and using our newsletters, communicate to the neighborhood any warnings that might be necessary based upon events reported by the Block Captains. The coordinator would maintain a telephone tree of all the Block Captains to communicate timely warnings of criminal activities if that became necessary. The Block Captains, would in turn, pass the warnings on to their blocks.

With the advent of email and message boards, the need for telephone communications became much less necessary and the role of the Block Captain lessoned a bit. Nevertheless, we still have a few active Block Captains in Winter Woods.

One of our last remaining Block Captains was Joyce Train on King Alpine's Court. Joyce passed in October. Even to the end she was passing along the names and numbers of the residents on her street. Thank you, Joyce. You will be missed.

While the role of the Block Captain has changed over the years, having a point of contact at the block level can still be very important. If you would like to be added to our Block Captain roles, please contact Larry Stephey.

On another note, it still is very important, and the law, to have visible house numbers on your residence. As we travel the neighborhood looking at Christmas lights for a possible award, it is often difficult to spot the house number. Emergency responders could be delayed without an easy way to see your house number.

If you would rather pay by credit/debit card or your PayPal account, you can do that, too. We finished 2022 with 129 members or 45.74% of our neighborhood, just a few shy

The evening of December 18 was cold but bright with many holiday decorations and lights as the Winter Woods Decorations committee members started their search to find the best-decorated homes in Winter Woods. We are happy to report that the spirit of holiday decorating was very much alive in Winter Woods with many homes participating!

We found numerous homes qualifying for award consideration. We were pleased to be able to award the top awards to the following residences:

The Foyil family residence at 2210 King Charles was the choice of committee members for the "Over-the-Top Award"!

The Recob family residence at 2019 Japonica won the "Santa's Choice Award".

The presentation at the Schuermann family home at 2118 Poinciana won the "President's Award".

The display at the Richardson residence at 1520 Nottingham, was the winner of the "Committee's Award".

Winners were presented with a sign for display on their front lawns during the remainder of the holiday season. Though there were several contenders for the top awards, the household had to be a 2022 paid member of the Winter Woods Homeowners Association to receive one of the four top awards. In the event of a tie, judges give the award to homes which have not previously received a top award.

Many houses showed off the outstanding decorating efforts of the residents and received **Honorable Men-tion**, and the following is a list of those homes:

The displays at 2238, 2239, and 2251 Coventry looked great!

The **Hampton Circles** had many nice decorations, and we were especially appreciative of the displays at 2125, 2132, 2137, and 2143 **North Hampton**, 2001 and 2018 **West Hampton**, and 1907, 1917, 1918, 1925, 1941, 1942, 2027, 2028, and 2052 **East Hampton**.

On Japonica, the displays at 1907, 1928, 1935, 1942, 1956, 1977, and 2012 were delightful.

King Alpines was well represented by the homes at 2201, 2208, 2214, and 2225.

We found nicely decorated homes at 1946, 1953, 1957, 1960, 1961, and 1964 King Arthurs.

King Charles had beautiful displays at 2209 and 2215.

King Edwards was well represented by the home at 2263.

The homes at 2241, 2244, 2256, 2259, 2265, and 2268 King James were shining brightly.

King Johns residences celebrating the spirit of the season were noted at 2241, 2252, 2258, 2259, and 2265.

King Henrys had homes at 2246, 2257, 2263, 2269, 2272, and 2276 adding to the beauty of the neighborhood.

King Richards homes at 2211, 2218, and 2223 added to the warmth of the holiday season.

The displays at 1463, 1503, 1519, 1535, 1560, 1707, 1825, 1841, 2013, 2029, 2115, 2131, and 2155 Nottingham were quite noteworthy.

Poinciana looked good with decorations of note at 1810, 1816, 1843, 1887, 1940, 1958, 2047, 2067, 2077, 2080, 2089, 2092, 2097, 2122, 2251, 2252, 2312, and 2316.

Sussex was represented with homes at 2017, 2021, 2032, 2036, 2037, 2086, 2157, and 2177 deserving mention.

Participating on **Tamerine** was the residence at 2255.

Worthy of honorable mention on Winter Woods Blvd. were the residences at 2212 and 2224.

Committee members had difficulty locating the house numbers on many homes in Winter Woods. We encourage all residents to make sure your address numbers are always clearly visible from the street so that emergency responders can quickly identify your home! This is a safety issue far more important than holiday decorations.
