

Meet Your Neighbor—By Laura Spear



It would be hard to find neighbors who love our area more than Maureen and Rich Rabazinski. They have literally lived and worked in a 3-mile radius in Winter Park for 38 years, 9 of which in their current home they share with their friendly golden-doodle Riley.

Their story as a couple began in 1985 at Duquesne University in Pittsburg where Rich was getting his Masters degree and Maureen was a freshman nursing student. They married a year later and came to Winter Park for Rich's job at the FL Department of Revenue where he worked for 5 years. Rich then moved on to be a Sales Tax Consultant mainly for hotels traveling around the country for 27 years before he semi-retired a few years ago. Maureen began her career as a registered nurse, then when back to UCF to become a geriatric nurse practitioner, most recently at Advent Health.

About a year ago she founded a telehealth company called My Memory Clinic. Now serving over 225 patients throughout the state of Florida who are concerned about their memory, have a mild cognitive

impairment, and Alzheimer's disease, her company will soon be participating in Alzheimer's research working towards a cure.

Maureen and Rich raised two sons in Winter Park, Corey 35, who played football for UCF and Andrew 32, who played Lacrosse for UNF. They declare themselves doting grandparents to Corey and his wife Carly's three children, Avery, 7, Everly, 3, and Mason 1 ½. They visit often and they love the chaos that 3 kids and a rambunctious dog create. Even though they raised their family in Florida, they still hold on to their roots, cheering for the Pittsburgh Steelers and cooking Polish food during the holidays.

During all their moving around in Winter Park, they have done a lot of home remodeling. They have flipped 8 houses in the area, including one they still own on Lakemont that they rent out as an AirBnb mainly to people who need a place to live while THEIR house is being remodeled. They love to put special touches in their remodeling. In a 3-story house they lived in just west of Lakemont, they created a "Hall of Friends" where 236 of their friends left a handprint and then decorated it to match their personality. Rich says, "we're seriously thinking about doing something like that here." When they first moved into their current house, they did some pretty major remodeling and had the pleasure of inviting the previous owners back to see the changes.

So WHY have they loved Winter Park for so many years? They say it's "location, location, location!" They enjoy the access to all kinds of fun things to do, the variety of restaurants, from gourmet to hamburger joints. They confess to being "Foodies" and believe this is an amazing place to be. And as for what they love about Winter Woods? "I just love the sidewalks are so big, I sit out in the front yard with Riley and talked to people as they walk by, everyone is so friendly," said Maureen. "I walk Riley everyday, and there's so many people walking their dogs too, it's nice to meet people," said Rich. "I remember reading an article before we moved to Florida about Winter Park," shared Maureen, "it said you're going to want to live here and work here and play here. And I thought that would be boring, but you know, that's exactly what we've done!"


