NEIGHBORHOOD WATCH—Larry Stephey

We had an excellent turnout at October's Neighborhood Night Out. Most of us met new friends who share many of the same concerns regarding crime and safety in our neighborhood. It was especially nice to have representatives from the Seminole County Fire Department present. They had to leave for a brief time because they were assigned to two separate runs. The adults were as excited as the youngsters to explore the equipment.

Unfortunately, although requested, we did not see a representative from the Seminole Sheriff. Apparently, there were too many ongoing calls for service that evening to spare a deputy. The central office for our Community Service Area (CSA) is in Oviedo. That office is headed by Lt. Robert Smith Jr.

After the event, I asked for an appointment with Lt. Smith, and we discussed the situation with coverage here in Winer Woods. He told me that currently the Sheriff Office in our (East) district is somewhat shorthanded and our CSA is not fully covered, but he expects to have more deputies assigned to the East District soon, as they are currently in training. Lt. Smith did provide statistics showing 310 calls for service in Winter Woods during the past twelve months. Nevertheless, our neighborhood continues to be one of the safest in Seminole County.

In the meantime, Lt. Smith has asked his deputies to patrol Winter Woods more aggressively in the next few weeks. We do have some traffic issues here which could be more controlled. While much of the traffic problem is with cut-through drivers, neighbors can sometimes be the issue too.

Please drive safely and don't be one of the few with new tickets to pay.

Lights: it took a second call to get a light repaired on Japonica and Poinciana. The folks that live near that light cannot believe how dark it was without it, glad to see it's back up.


Streets: I will call in an area of potholes/bad edges near St John's Court. N Nottingham!


Sidewalks: 5 areas of sidewalk have been inspected this past 2 weeks and area ready for
