## Tree Trimming for Duke Energy Power Lines

One of our neighbors (thanks Charles) called to tell me that the power lines that run on the back side of properties on Sussex between High St and Poinciana Rd needed some attention with the storm season upon us. I did some research and found the Request Tree Trimming - Duke Energy (dukeenergy.com) website. I submitted a request and DUKE got back to me right away with an email, a text, and a phone call. They have scheduled a crew to assess and remove in the next 10 days. DUKE will only come out if there is a branch touching one of their power lines, not the other communication lines or service lines. If you see any power lines that are being touched by a limb, please use this request link to get DUKE on the job. These limbs are the ones that cause power outages during storms.
