



Amateur Radio in Winer Woods—Bob Colbert

With the hurricane season about to open, maybe it is time to think about what happens when the power, cable, and cell service quit. There are at least a half dozen amateur radio operators in the neighborhood and probably more. These dedicated radio operators have a backup communications source to get help. Many of the radios are battery powered and offer a communications path directly to the Emergency Operations Center in Sanford!

As a reminder for our amateur operators, the national Simplex channel for VHF is 146.520 MHz. This is where the operators can talk, short distance, to each other for coordination or neighborhood surveys. The Seminole County Emergency Operations Center uses a repeater that is located on a county tower and has emergency power and operates on 147.090 MHz. This is important because these communications paths work regardless of Internet, Cell phone, or local power. Remember, you must have an amateur radio license issued by the Federal Communications Commission to operate on these frequencies.

As a note for everyone, when the commercial power fails, your internet provider can also got out. They may have backup systems in place for up to four hours of operation without commercial power which is an industry standard. We all know how inconvenient it is when the internet/cable go out. There is a backup for you that is relatively inexpensive. You can purchase an antenna for your TV that works as long as you can power the TV. There are over 80 channels, including all of the "local" channels and this can help you keep up with what's going on outside of Winter Woods in a hurricane or other disaster.

Stav safe! Remember – DO NOT RUN A GENERATOR IN YOUR GARAGE OR NEAR AN OPEN DOOR OR WINDOW TO YOUR HOUSE. CARBON MONOXIDE IS COLORLESS AND ODORLESS! Ten feet from your doors or windows is the preferred distance. And doors include the GARAGE DOOR.


