





STREETS & LIGHTING—Greg Pfister

<u>Lighting:</u> Last 30-day activity in Winter Woods looks like this: 1535 Nottingham Blvd. was called in and repaired. 2255 Tamerine St. is currently under repair; they need 15 business days to get it fixed. 2213 and 2353 Winter Woods Blvd. are now repaired.

Streets: I have been working hard trying to get some of our streets repaved here in Winter Woods for the last 4 years. As you can see for yourselves and I'm HAPPY to report that Seminole County Road Division has repaved Poinciana Rd., King Arthur's Ct., East. Hampton Circle, North Hampton Circle, and Sussex Rd.

Also, Casselberry Water did a pipe repair in the street at 2210 King Charles Ct. in July As of this writing, they still have not laid asphalt down. I called them and they stated it will be closer to the end of August when we are totally repaired, and they can take their cones away.

<u>Sidewalks:</u> With the Watermain Project behind us Casselberry Water put the finishing touches with new sidewalks and sod in the damaged areas.

<u>Community Improvements:</u> On a hot summer day Gerlinde and I put new paint on the 3 little entrance signs with gold lettering to match the big main entrance sign. What a busy but productive summer we had.
