MEMBERSHIP—Nell Colbert



MEET YOUR NEIGHBOR—Ed Measom



Sometimes the house that almost got away turns out to be exactly the right one. This month, we're excited to introduce Mark and Amanda Lopez, who live on the corner of King Johns Court and Nottingham—and whose Winter Woods story proves that second choices can be the best choices of all.

Back in December 2020, Mark and Amanda found themselves in a bidding war (because of course they did) and ended up purchasing what was technically their second-choice home in the neighborhood. Thanks to Mark's service in the Navy, they didn't officially move in until November of the following year. In the meantime, Amanda's brother stepped in as the home's first resident—and enjoyed the area so much that he now lives just around the corner. Both Mark and Amanda grew up in Wellington, Florida, near West Palm Beach, where they also attended school. Their home had already been mostly remodeled by the previous owner, but Mark and Amanda quickly made it their own by adding a beautiful backyard patio, installing new windows, and giving the interior a fresh coat of paint. Then came what might be their luckiest moment yet: while attending a UCF football game, they entered a QR-code contest for a free roof—complete with solar panels—and actually won. Amanda works in her family's real estate business, supporting agents with follow-ups and closing details, while Mark is a project manager for a construction company who occasionally visits job sites but mostly works remotely. They love being close to downtown Winter Park and appreciate the safety and peacefulness of the neighborhood. When they're not working, they enjoy spending time outdoors and often take their dog, Luna, to Baldwin Park and around Orlando.

And now for the biggest news of all: Mark and Amanda are expecting their first child in early May! They're looking forward to starting this new chapter—and raising our newest neighbor—right here in Winter Woods.
